Debtor.) CONFIRMATION HEARING

IT IS ORDERED setting an continued evidentiary hearing on confirmation of the Joint Plan of Reorganization for December 6, 2005 commencing at 10:00 a.m in Courtroom 603, Sixth Floor, 230 North First Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona. The hearing will address all outstanding objections to confirmation other than (1) substantive consolidation, and (2) classification of Class 4 creditors, both of which are set for hearing at another time. The Court believes the remaining objections include: (1) good faith; (2) whether the individuals proposed to serve as officers and directors of the reorganized debtor are consistent with the interests of creditors and equity security holders and public policy; (3) application of the "best interests" test as to Classes 3 and 4; and (4) application of the "absolute priority rule" as to Class 4.

All parties who wish to present evidence at the hearing shall participate in the preparation of a joint pretrial statement to be filed by noon, December 1, 2005 that identifies: (1) the issues to be litigated, including each party's position on such issues; (2) exhibits to be offered in evidence; and (3) witnesses to be called or transcripts of witness statements to be

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1 offered in evidence. Any party wishing to file a pretrial memorandum of law providing legal
2 argument and authorities in support of that party's position shall do so no later than noon,
3 December 1, 2005. Plan proponents shall, by noon December 1, 2005, upload on e-orders and
4 serve on all objectors a proposed order confirming the plan and proposed findings of fact and
5 conclusions of law. Any objector may, but is not required to, similarly upload and serve a
6 proposed order denying confirmation and proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law.
